

# ■ Highlighting Historic Ships for WWII's 75th Commemoration



This year marks seventy-five years since the end of World War II. Highlighting the commemoration will be a series of events in Hawai'i culminating on September 2 in a ceremony in Pearl Harbor, marking the allies' signing of the instrument of surrender aboard the USS *Missouri* (BB 63) in Tokyo Bay in 1945.
