The Missouri’s knowledgeable tour guides take groups through areas never before available including boiler, plotting and engine rooms where they’ll get hands-on training with lessons on lighting one of the eight, three-story Babcock and Wilcox boilers and adjusting the throttles releasing the steam that drives the ship’s massive propellers. Guests are also introduced via video to the ship’s last Chief Engineer, Larry Doong, as he provides video commentary throughout Broadway, the longest and widest passage on the ship.

Admission to The Heart of the Missouri Tour is \$25 per adult and \$12 per child. General admission, which includes your choice of a four tours, is \$22 per adult and \$11 per child 4-12. The Battleship Missouri Memorial, located a mere ship’s length from the USS Arizona Memorial, completes a historical visitor experience beginning with the “day of infamy” that saw the sinking of USS Arizona in Pearl Harbor and ending with Imperial Japan’s unconditional surrender aboard USS Missouri in Tokyo Bay. Following an astounding career that spans five decades and three wars, from World War II to the Korean conflict to the Liberation of Kuwait, the “Mighty Mo” was decommissioned and donated to the USS Missouri Memorial Association, Inc., a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, which operates the battleship as a historic attraction and memorial. The association oversees her care and preservation with the support of visitors, memberships, grants and the generosity of donors. Named one of Hawai‘i’s top 10 attractions by Pacific Business News, the Battleship Missouri Memorial has welcomed over 5-million guests and starred in Universal Studios’ Battleship.
