

VOLUNTEER SAFETY BRIEF

Welcome! The USS Missouri Memorial Association would like to thank you for service. Your presence indicates that you are willing to help in the restoration and upkeep of this historic ship. As a volunteer, you are an important element in the daily activities of the Battleship Missouri and we have certain safety guidelines that you must adhere to:

1. The Battleship Missouri Memorial Association does not allow volunteers under the age of 16.
2. Bring only essential items with you;
3. Tools and supplies are provided by the ship;
4. Wear your volunteer badge or pin at all times unless with a group;
5. Wear appropriate clothing and footwear, closed toe shoes are mandatory;
6. You **will** wear eye protection at all times.
7. Safety gear, gloves, rubber gloves, eye protection, dust masks, provided by ship;
8. Use safety gear when needed;
9. Close hatches and doors behind you, secure lanyards and barriers after you go through them;
10. Do not venture into any unauthorized areas unless cleared and escorted by Missouri staff;
11. Observe and comply with all signage;
12. Be careful using stairs and ladders, face them as you go up and down;
13. No running on the ship or pier;
14. Drink lots of water;
15. Take breaks in the Volunteer Tent;
16. Do not drink sodas or eat food on the ship;
17. Put tools and gear away in the volunteer tool room;
18. Take bagged trash to the dumpster on the pier;
19. Clean up after each work day;
20. Do not remove ship's gear;
21. Report safety hazards to Volunteer Staff;
22. All injuries, no matter how small must be reported to volunteer staff and ship's security;
23. Life's short-work hard and have fun;
